

What Makes a Trained Leader?

- **Cub Scout leaders** are considered trained when they have completed This Is Scouting (Replaces New Leader Essentials) and the Cub Scout Leader Specific training for their position.
- **Scoutmasters and assistant Scoutmasters** are considered trained when they have completed This Is Scouting (Replaces New Leader Essentials), Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training, and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.
- **Troop committee members** are considered trained when they have completed This Is Scouting (Replaces New Leader Essentials) and the Troop Committee Challenge as their Leader Specific training.
- **Varsity Scout leaders and assistants** are considered trained when they have completed This Is Scouting (Replaces New Leader Essentials), Varsity Scout Leader Specific Training (available April 2002), and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.
- **Venturing crew Advisors, assistant Advisors, and crew committee members** are considered trained when they have completed This Is Scouting (Replaces New Leader Essentials) and Venturing Leader Specific Training.
